Itinerary

Day 1: Reach Manali in the morning. Accommodate in hotel and roam around.

Day 2: Drive to Bharatpur tent colony (4700 m). Distance is 200 Km, will take around 6

hours. Stay in camp.

Day 3: active acclimatisation day, height gain up to 5200 m and back. 5/6 hours.

Day 4: Climb and set up Summit camp (5300 m) – 4 hours

Day 5: acclimatisation.

Day 6: Early morning (by 2 am) start ascending Yunam peak (6100 m) summit and

descent to summit Camp. – 10/11 hours

Day 7: Summit camp to Bharatpur base camp(3 hours) and Drive back to Manali – 200

Km - 6/7 hours. Stay in hotel

Day 8: Departure after breakfast.

Cost Terms

Hotel accommodation at Manali on twin/triple sharing basis with breakfast and dinner.
